1. Airservices customers of Automatic Fire Alarm Monitoring Services (Customers) may place orders for the Products directly from Airservices under these terms and conditions.
2. Customers may place Orders for the Products by completing the details and following the instructions on this Order Form. By placing an Order, Customer makes an offer to enter into an agreement to purchase the Products. Orders will be deemed to have been received by Airservices Australia at the time Airservices Australia sends a confirmation of the Order to Customer's nominated email address.
3. The pricing made available on Airservices Australia's website at the time of an Order is placed with Airservices Australia will be valid and open for acceptance by Customers. Airservices Australia reserves the right to modify the pricing in relation to the Products from time to time.
4. Airservices Australia will invoice the Customer for payment upon delivery of the Products.
5. Airservices Australia will deliver the Products purchased by the Customer to the Customer's address specified in this Order or such other place as the Customer specifies and agreed by Airservices Australia. Any date of delivery specified by Airservices Australia is an estimate only. Whilst Airservices Australia will endeavour to deliver the Products by the date specified, if any, it shall not be liable in any way for delay in delivery howsoever caused, nor shall such a delay entitle the Customer to reject the Products or treat this agreement as repudiated or render Airservices Australia liable for damages in any way.
6. All stock availability of the Products may be subject to change without notice. If, for any reason, Airservices Australia does not have enough stock of the Products and cannot supply the Products which Customer has ordered, Airservices Australia will advise Customer. Airservices Australia reserves the right to reject any order the Customer places with Airservices Australia, and/or or to limit quantities on any individual Order.
7. Notwithstanding delivery of the Products to Customer, title in the Products will not pass to Customer until the later of delivery or Customer's payment has been processed or otherwise received by Airservices Australia.
8. Risk of loss or damage to any Products will pass to Customer on delivery.

11. The Product may come with a manufacturer's warranty from Romteck Australia Pty Ltd. The manufacturer's warranty is in addition to but may overlap with any rights and remedies Customer may have under applicable law, including any Implied Terms.
